







# Active since 2005, created by CUP 2000 SpA for the Emilia-Romagna Region, the Local Authorities and the Local Health Trust of Bologna.

The network of citizens, associations, institutions and professionals, able to provide support to the frail elderly aiming at:

- favoring the long staying of the elderly in their homes
- preventing the increase of not-self sufficiency conditions
- improving the quality of life by fighting social isolation
- allowing the fruition of healthcare and social services
- reducing unnecessary hospital admissions.

The target of the service is represented by the frail elderly over 75, at risk of social isolation. The service is free of charge.

## The innovation

The service performs a constant monitoring of frailty by means of a periodical personalised support and the promotion of lifestyles addressing the improvement of health conditions and adherence to medical treatments. The close cooperation of volunteers, associations and institutional operators granted the success of the service, which has been able, over the years, to facilitate a higher level of integration between services and good practices on the territory. The further innovation of the services and the development of new ICT solutions will allow an effective management and prevention of frailty.

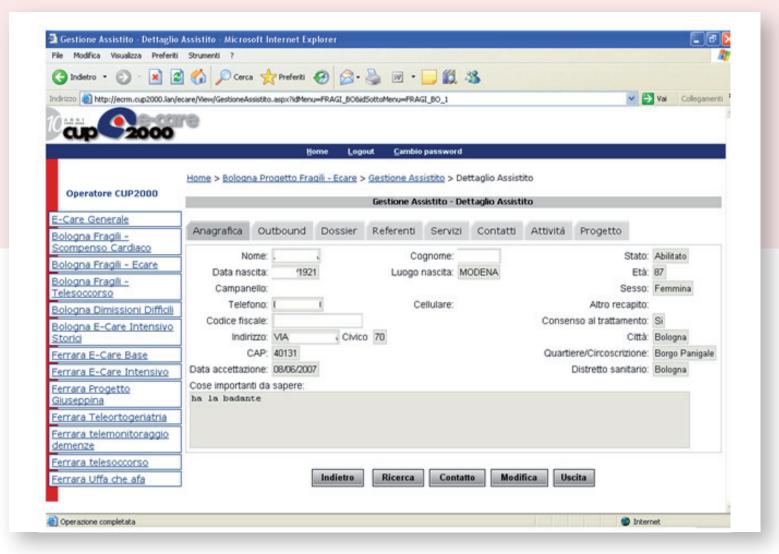
## The e-Care call center activity

Skilled and trained operators available inbound and outbound, providing telemonitoring according to the Individual Assistance Plan.



#### The socio-health dossier

Operative tool managed by the call center operators to perform the best and personalized monitoring (personal data, frailty factors, health status, medications...)



#### The frailty database

Collects, elaborates and aggregates the individual's clinical and social information, as a mean of prevention and detection of possible assistential unmet needs.
